Himawari-9 successfully launched

2 November 2016 Japan Meteorological Agency

The new-generation geostationary meteorological satellite of the Japan Meteorological Agency, Himawari-9, was successfully launched using H-IIA Launch Vehicle No. 31 at 6:20 UTC on 2 November 2016 from the Tanegashima Space Center in Kagoshima, Japan.

The satellite successfully separated from the launch vehicle about 28 minutes after lift-off, and will fly unaided for around 10 days before settling into geostationary orbit.
