Meet us at Pembroke Castle's Christmas Market.

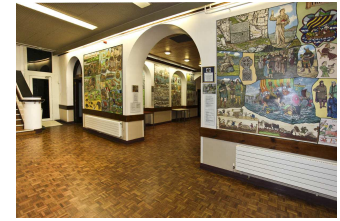
