## **Call for Papers**

Clinical psychology is the psychological specialty that provides continuing and comprehensive mental and behavioral health care for individuals and families; consultation to agencies and communities; training, education and supervision; and research-based practice.

Health psychology is a specialty area that focuses on how biology, psychology, behavior, and social factors influence health and illness. Other terms including medical psychology and behavioral medicine are sometimes used interchangeably with the term health psychology.

In this special issue, we intend to invite front-line researchers and authors to submit original research and review articles on **Clinical and Health Psychology**. Potential topics include, but are not limited to:

- Psychological factors and Treatments
- Clinical characteristics of mental disorders
- Psychological interventions for diseases and disorders
- Health promotion, illness prevention and quality of life
- Psychological functioning and mechanism
- Psychopathology and psychotherapy

- Psychometric properties and evaluation
- Risk factors
