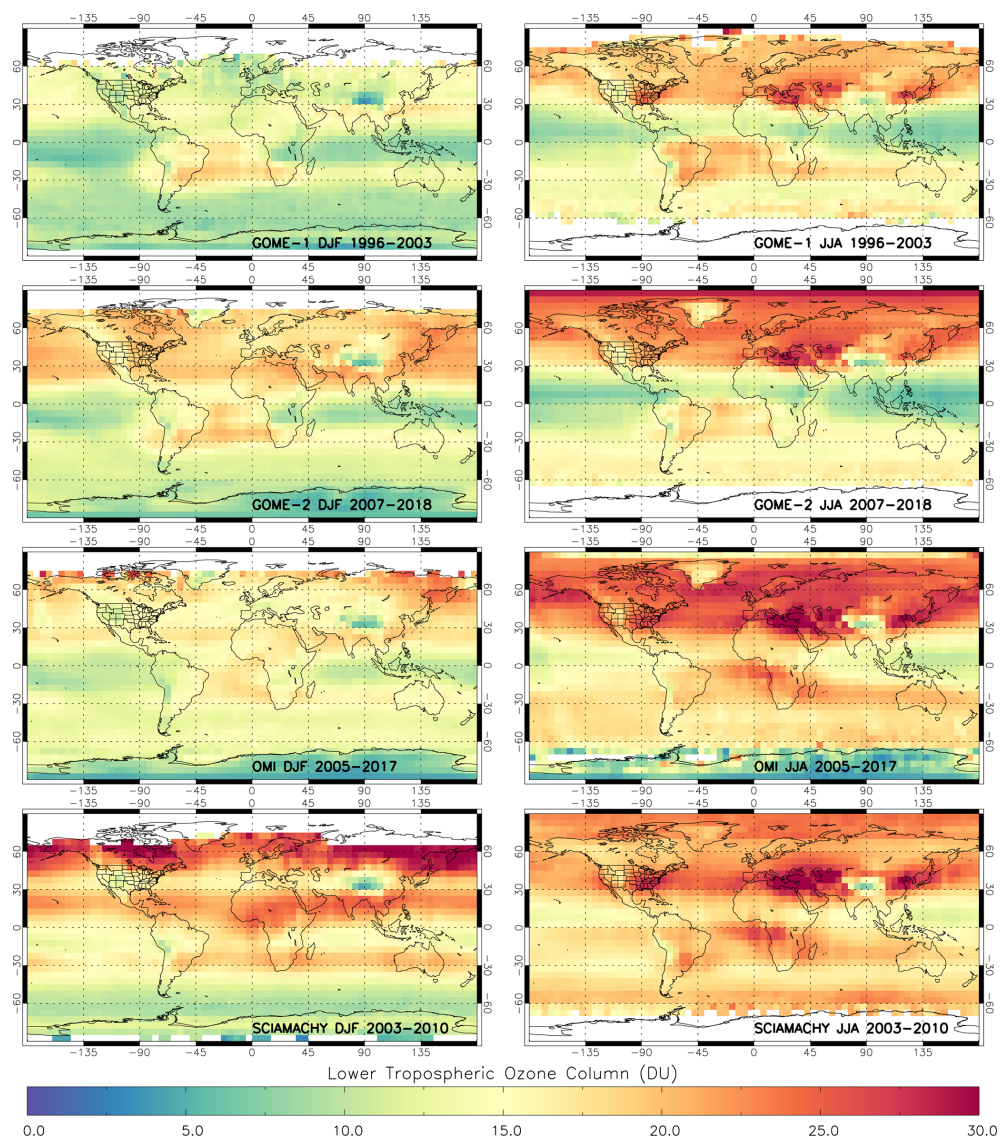


Figure 4. Seasonal distributions of LTCO₃ in December–January–February (DJF) and June–July–August (JJA) for GOME-1, GOME-2, OMI and SCIAMACHY averaged over the full record for each instrument.

The bottom two panels of the original Fig. 4 are incorrect and are duplicates of the Ozone Monitoring Instrument (OMI) lower tropospheric ozone (LTCO₃, surface–450 hPa) panel for June–July–August (JJA). These two panels should show SCanning Imaging Absorption spectroMeter for Atmospheric CartographY (SCIAMACHY) LTCO₃ for December–January–February (DJF) and JJA. All the article text and figure captions (including Fig. 4) are correct. The corrected Fig. 4 is below:
