As you may know, on Feb. 24, 2022 Russia invaded Ukraine. The war continues to be fought in Ukraine's eastern and southeastern regions.

Since the beginning of the invasion, there have been thousands of deaths, including civilians. More than 250,000 Russian and Ukrainian soldiers have been killed or wounded. The Canadian government has provided support to Ukraine throughout the conflict, including more than \$1 billion in military assistance. The Canadian government has also implemented sanctions against Russian individuals, businesses and the government in response to the invasion.
