

How to get to Bolling Hall on public transport.

The nearest train station to Bolling Hall is Bradford Interchange, which is 1.1 miles from Bolling Hall.

The nearest bus stop to Bolling Hall is the Wakefield Road/Lister Avenue stop. This is approximately a 10-minute walk from Bolling Hall. The buses that serve this stop are 256, 263, 283, 425, 617, 618, 620. These all start at Bradford Interchange Bus Station and go towards Wakefield, Dewsbury, Holme Wood, and Bierley.

Below is a list of those bus routes, with the primary schools directly on each route.

256 – St Columba’s Catholic Primary, St John’s CofE, East Bierley Primary, Whitechapel Church of England, Heaton Avenue Primary School, High Bank Primary.

263 – St Columba’s Catholic Primary, Birkenshaw CE Primary, Gomersal Primary School, Gomersal St Mary’s, Heaton Avenue Primary School, High Bank, Headlands CofE, Roberttown CofE, Crossley Fields, Old Bank Academy, Battyeford CofE, Crowlees CofE, Ravensthorpe CofE, St Paulinus Catholic Primary.

283 – St Columba’s Catholic Primary, St John’s CofE, Birkenshaw Primary, St Patrick’s Catholic Primary, St Peter’s CofE Birstall, Batley Parish CofE, Purlwell Infant School, Hyrstmount Junior School.

425 – St Columba’s Catholic Primary, Drightlington Primary, Birchfield Primary, Gildersome Primary, Morley Victoria Primary, St Francis Catholic Primary Morley, Seven Hills Primary, Blackgates Primary, Wrenthorpe Academy.

617 – Academy St James, St Matthew’s Catholic Primary, Ley Top Primary, Allerton Primary, Lilycroft Primary, St Philips CE Primary, Miriam Lord Primary, Iqra Academy, Atlas Community Primary, Dixons Manningham Primary, Green Lane Primary, Knowleswood Primary, Ryecroft Primary.

618 – Academy St James, St Matthew’s Catholic Primary, Ley Top Primary, Allerton Primary, Lilycroft Primary, St Philips CE, Miriam Lord Primary, Iqra Academy, Atlas Community Primary, Dixons Manningham Primary, Green Lane Primary, Carrwood Primary, Ryecroft Primary, Knowleswood Primary.

620 – Beckfoot Heaton, Margaret McMillan, Carlton Mills Primary, Lilycroft Primary, Westbourne Primary, Green Lane Primary, Newhall Park Primary, St John’s CofE.

How to walk to Bolling Hall from the bus stop

If you arrive at the Wakefield Road/Lister Avenue stop on a bus heading away from Bradford Interchange, you will alight outside the PDSA hospital as shown in photo 1. If your bus is heading towards Bradford Interchange, you will get off the bus outside Wakefield Road Trade Park, as shown in photo 2.



If you got off the bus outside the PDSA hospital, you need to cross over the road using the large crossing that will be to your right as you get off the bus. This is shown in photo 3. If you got off the bus outside the Wakefield Road Trade Centre, stay on this side of the road



You are looking for Lister Avenue. It is a large road with houses on either side and a postbox on the corner. It is directly opposite the crossing and traffic lights, as shown in photos 4 and 5.

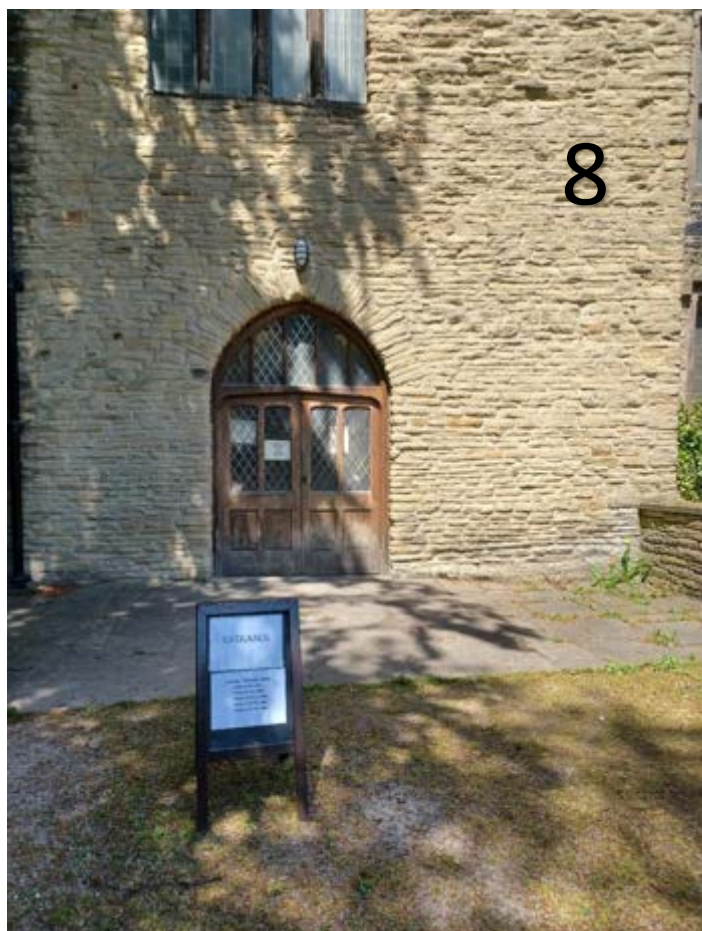


Walk down Lister Avenue. When you reach the end, you will see the gates of Bowling Park and the Lodge Cafe in front of you, as shown in photo 6.



Turn right down Bowling Hall Road. The park will be on your left. After a short while, you will see a sign for Bolling Hall Museum and a flight of steps (photo 7)

If you are able to, take the flight of steps up to Bolling Hall. This will bring you directly opposite the main entrance (photo 8). If you are unable to use the steps, continue in the same direction along Bowling Hall Road. There will shortly be a turning to the right called Brompton Avenue (photo 9). Turn right down Brompton Avenue.



Continue along Brompton Avenue until you reach another sign for Bolling Hall Museum and the car park (photo 10). Enter via this entrance. You will be able to walk around the outside of the building to the main entrance.
