Privacy Statement

The European Education and Culture Executive Agency ("EACEA") is committed to preserving your privacy. All personal data are dealt with in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 2018/1725 on the protection of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies¹ ("the data protection regulation").

The following Privacy statement outlines the policies by which the EACEA collects, manages and uses the personal data of the concerned individuals within the National Policies Platform website (https://national-policies.eacea.ec.europa.eu).

1. Who is responsible for processing your personal data (data controller)?

The controller is the European Education and Culture Executive Agency, BE-1049 Brussels The person designated as being in charge of the processing operation is the Head of Unit EACEA.A6 Education and Youth Policy Analysis

2. Which personal data are processed?

E-mail address of the subscriber for receiving the newsletter.

3. For which purpose do we process your data?

Personal data is collected and processed for the purpose of sending the newsletter to those who have subscribed.

4. Who has access to your personal data and to whom is it disclosed?

Access to personal data is given on a need-to know basis to the following recipients:

- EACEA.A6 staff in charge of creating and editing the newsletter. This is a limited number of staff responsible for dissemination and communication activities
- European Commission DG CNECT(R3) technical service

The transfer of data to other third parties is prohibited.

5. How long do we keep your personal data?

The data is available as long as users wish to remain subscribed to the newsletters. If they decide to have their data deleted, they can do so by clicking on the relative link on the bottom of the newsletter ("manage my account"). Once data is deleted by a user, the data is also automatically erased from the

databases. If users who unsubscribed want to continue receiving the newsletter, they will need to subscribe again.

6. What are your rights concerning your personal data and how can you exercise them?

Under the provisions of the data protection regulation, you have the right to:

- Request to access the personal data EACEA holds about you;
- Request a rectification of your personal data where necessary;
- Request the erasure of your personal data;
- Request the restriction of the processing of your personal data;
- Request to receive or to have your data transferred to another organization in commonly used machine readable standard format (data portability).

In addition, as this processing of your personal data is based on your consentArticle 5(1)(d) of the data protection regulation, please note that you can withdraw it at any time, and this will have effect from the moment of your retraction. The processing based on your consent before its withdrawal will remain lawful.

7. Your right to have recourse in case of conflict on any personal data issue
