

COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 1191/2003
of 2 July 2003
correcting Regulation (EC) No 120/2003 on the issuing of export licences for wine-sector products

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EC) No 883/2001 of 24 April 2001 laying down detailed rules for implementing Council Regulation (EC) No 1493/1999 as regards trade with third countries in products in the wine sector⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 1175/2003⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 7 and Article 9(3) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) The Portuguese version of Article 1(2) of Commission Regulation (EC) No 120/2003⁽³⁾ is incomplete and the dates are the wrong way round. The Portuguese version should therefore be corrected accordingly.

- (2) Given that Regulation (EC) No 120/2003 entered into force on 25 January 2003, this Regulation should apply from the same date,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

This correction concerns only the Portuguese version.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

It shall apply from 25 January 2003.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
