European Parliament legislative resolution on the initiative of the Kingdom of Belgium and the Kingdom of Sweden with a view to adopting a Council decision extending Europol's mandate to deal with the serious forms of international crime listed in the Annex to the Europol Convention (9093/2001 – C5-0266/2001 – 2001/0817(CNS))

(Consultation procedure)

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the initiative of the Kingdom of Belgium and the Kingdom of Sweden (9093/2001)⁽¹⁾,
 - having been consulted by the Council pursuant to Article 39(1) of the EU Treaty (C5-0266/2001),
 - having regard to Rules 106 and 67 of its Rules of Procedure,
 - having regard to the report of the Committee on Citizens' Freedoms and Rights, Justice and Home Affairs (A5-0370/2001),
1. Approves the initiative of the Kingdom of Belgium and the Kingdom of Sweden as amended;
 2. Calls on the Council to alter the initiative accordingly;
 3. Calls on the Council to notify Parliament should it intend to depart from the text approved by Parliament;
 4. Asks to be consulted again if the Council intends to amend the initiative of the Kingdom of Belgium and the Kingdom of Sweden substantially;
 5. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council and Commission and the governments of the Kingdom of Belgium and of the Kingdom of Sweden.
