By virtue of Article 9 (1) of Council Regulation (EEC) No 3420/83 of 14 November 1983 on import arrangements for products originating in State-trading countries, not liberalized at Community level (1), the Commission has adopted the following change to the import arrangements applied in Italy with regard to Romania with effect from 1 July 1986:

Within the framework of the regime laid down by the Protocol to the Agreement between the Community and Romania on trade in industrial products, exceptional opening for 1986 of supplementary import possibilities, for the following product and amount:

— Unwrought aluminium billets, containing 99,5 % aluminium (CCT 76.01 ex A): 2 000 tonnes.

By Decision dated 1 July 1986 the Commission has authorized the French Republic not to apply Community treatment to woven fabrics of cotton and woven fabrics of synthetic fibres (discontinuous), falling within heading No 55.09 and subheading 56.07 A of the Common Customs Tariff (categories 2 and 3), originating in Thailand and in free circulation in the other Member States.

The said Decision is applicable from 1 July to 30 November 1986.

By Decision dated 2 July 1986 the Commission has authorized the French Republic not to apply Community treatment to handkerchiefs of woven fabrics, falling within heading No 61.05 of the Common Customs Tariff (category 19), originating in Hungary and in free circulation in the other Member States.

The said Decision is applicable from 1 July to 31 December 1986.
