

Why Should You Read The 500 Page Cost Centre Document?

You, the leaders, shouldn't read it, but your top policy, security and financial advisors and your analysts should. Why?

The new legal identity, credential and learning architecture is analogous to creating a new air traffic control system. When you get on a plane, you aren't thinking about security, identification of the planes as they cross international air space, ground control, etc. You assume it all "works". Yet, "underneath the hood" are literally thousands of pages of manuals, standards, international agreements, and funding to make the end-to-end system work.

The cost centre document is the first step towards creating a secure, end-to-end legal identity, credential and learning system which instantly works locally as well as globally.

It begins with several "vision" sections describing, at the 100,000-foot level what the major components do. Then it dives into the details. It's complicated, which is why it includes detailed descriptions for 294 subcomponent cost centres.

The architecture creates two, new, extremely well-funded, global, independent non-profits (each with annual funding of over \$1 billion) to manage most of the costs and create standards.

Further, the non-profits do 24x7x365 threat analysis. Why? The assumption is most local state/provincial jurisdictions don't have the resources, expertise, or budget to continually defend their new legal and learning architectures against the Evil Inc.'s [and daily new attacks from this tech change curve](#). The non-profits continually produce rated threats. So, for very high threats citizens, companies, enterprises, and governments must respond to within hours. This brings current industry best practices to legal identity and learning.

A major political challenge is for your federal government to get on board your local state/provinces administering the CRVS systems. To rapidly get their buy-in, your government can offer one-time subsidies of between \$500-900 million per local state/provincial jurisdiction.

Within the accompanying Excel spreadsheet, for each cost centre bearing costs, it shows notes on the guesstimates assumptions used.
