Nuclear Energy Agency

- Small size and budget
 (80 staff members; budget of 14 million euros).
- ➤ Large representation (85% of the world's nuclear power capacity) (nuclear energy supplies 1/4 of total OECD electricity).
- Non-political forum; climate of mutual trust.
- Pools world's best nuclear expertise among developed countries.
- Narrow focus: in-depth scientific, technical, legal work.
