As of 2013 the CDC and U.S. Preventive Services Task Force have recommended that all “Baby Boomers” be tested once for Hepatitis C.

- Hepatitis C is a blood-borne virus that causes serious liver damage.
- Hepatitis C often has no symptoms but can lead to cirrhosis, liver cancer and the need for a transplant.
- There are many ways that people can be infected with the Hepatitis C virus.
- Effective treatment is available for people with Hepatitis C.
