
A VISUAL COMPARISON OF THE GENERATION 2 AND 3 BAM 1020 PARTICULATE MONITORS

This guide is intended to help customers using the BAM 1020 Particulate Monitor differentiate between the 2nd and 3rd generation versions of the instrument.

In addition to the visual differences shown below, the serial numbers also have different formatting. The 2nd generation BAM 1020 serial number is a single letter followed by four or five digits (such as A1234 or A12345), whereas the 3rd generation format inserts the letter “N” between the leading letter and the subsequent five digits (such as AN12345).

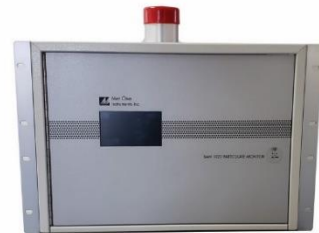
