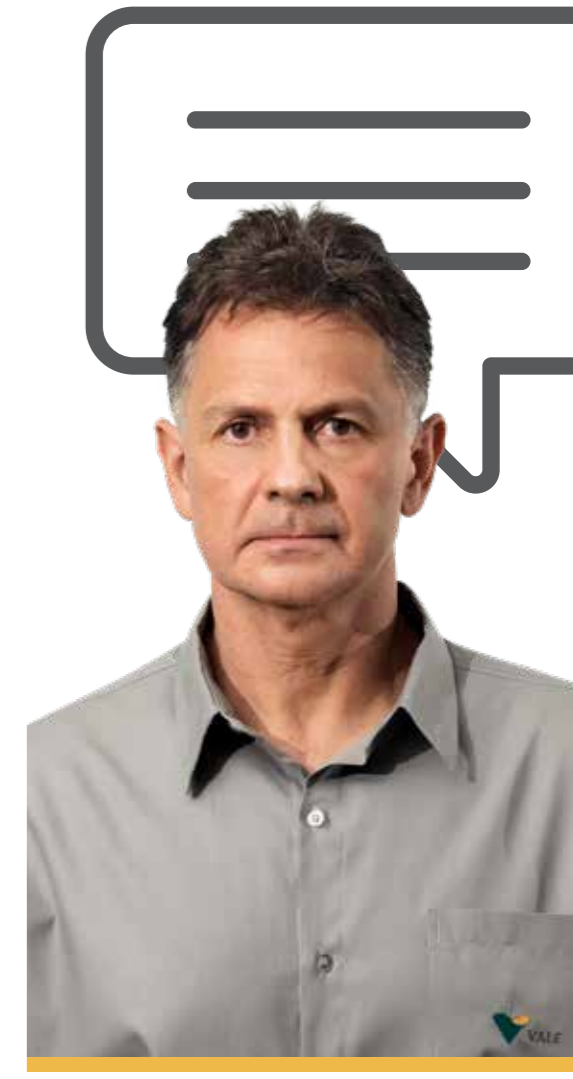
Message of the CEO

Message of the Director

This semester we sealed with the State of Minas Gerais and the Justice Institutions a commitment that we had already assumed internally and for which we have worked since 2019: the commitment to continue endeavoring all efforts towards fully repairing all damages caused to the people and municipalities affected. We recognize the existing difficulties and challenges like the restrictions imposed by the pandemic, and we are aware of the need of continuous improvement in our processes so we can comprehend the dissatisfactions and disagreements and work in search of solutions. Despite the challenges, we have evolved not only in the quantity of the people indemnified and assisted by our actions, but also in the execution of structuring projects that will be capable of helping in the remediation and development of the territories. Important to know about the Reparation



Full Reparation Agreement

The agreement executed with Vale, the Justice Institutions and the State of Minas Gerais, on the February 4th, reinforces the commitment to the full remediation of the environmental and social damages resulting from the rupture of the dam B1, in Brumadinho. The mediation process was conducted by the Court of Justice of Minas Gerais by means of the Judicial Center of Solution of Second Level Conflicts and Citizenship. The agreement contemplates socio-economic and socio-environmental remediation projects, to mitigate the impacts of the rupture of the dam on the State and affected regions. We continue determined to fully repair the damages caused and continue to be committed to the individual indemnifications to the affected people, keeping, as a purpose, the contribution to the improvement and development of the communities.

Search support

Vale keeps committed in supporting and improving the search conditions to the Military Fire Department of Minas Gerais. In addition to logistic support to the corporation, field improvements are also performed, like the drainage of the affected areas to avoid the wetting of tailings and opening of new ways to increase the ability to access the area. Together with the fire fighters, the company is studying the material disposed in the region to continue contributing with the search.

Prevention to Covid-19

In function of the pandemic, we are adopting rigid prevention protocols so that we can ensure the continuity of our activities in a safe way to our employees and to the community.

Valorizar Brumadinho Program

The 30 social organizations that had their projects selected in the public notice 2020 of the Valorizar Brumadinho Program have already demonstrated good results. With the financial resources received and the technical assistance that continues being offered, including capacitation, training and articulation of partnerships for the disclosure of products, the organization is managing to get stronger and applying solutions that optimize the social projects.



The São José Band is an example. Created in 2011, the social organization supports residents of the rural communities of Brumadinho through music. Ranked 4th in the Music and Art category, the organization has applied the digital model of lives and on-line classes to continue the work even during the pandemic. The social networks of the project were repositioned and started to assist students of other states.

Strengthening of the tourism and jobs generation

Fifty tourism entrepreneurs in Brumadinho, Igarapé, Juatuba, Mário Campos and São Joaquim de Bicas completed the cycle of the Project of Strengthening of Competitiveness of the Tourism Private Sector, held in partnership with Veredas Circuit.

Even with a 37.9% drop in the performance of the industry of tourism in Brazil (IBGE) last year, the entrepreneurs assisted by the program have recorded an average growth of more than 4% in annual billing and 18% in the number of job posts.

It was 4.1 thousand hours of consulting, ten tourist routes of experience created, 1,250 professional pictures taken and 190 people involved in the collective qualifications, thus contributing to the improvement of the services, the enhancement of the management and strengthening of the image of the region as competitive tourist destination.

Project Yara Tupynambá

In its final phase, the project Yara Tupynambá has already delivered 230 gardens and has 201 residences completed or in phase of completion. There was a delay in the works due to the pandemic and the new forecast is that by the end of August all renovations will be finished.

The work conducted by the Institute Yara Tupynambá has qualified 144 residents of Córrego do Feijão and Parque da Cachoeira, leading to more employability to these people. In parallel, the project is renovating 230 residences and has executed 230 gardens, both chosen by the own students.

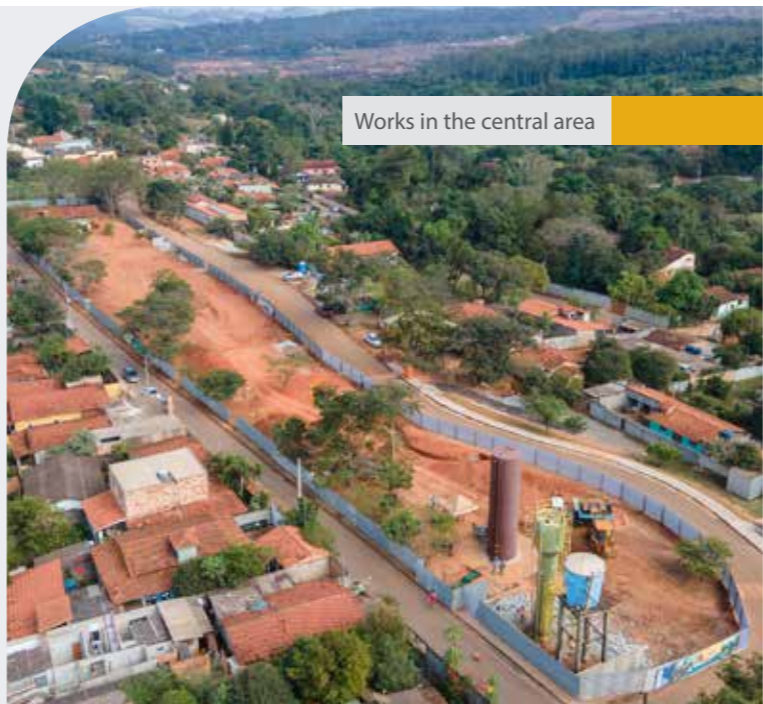

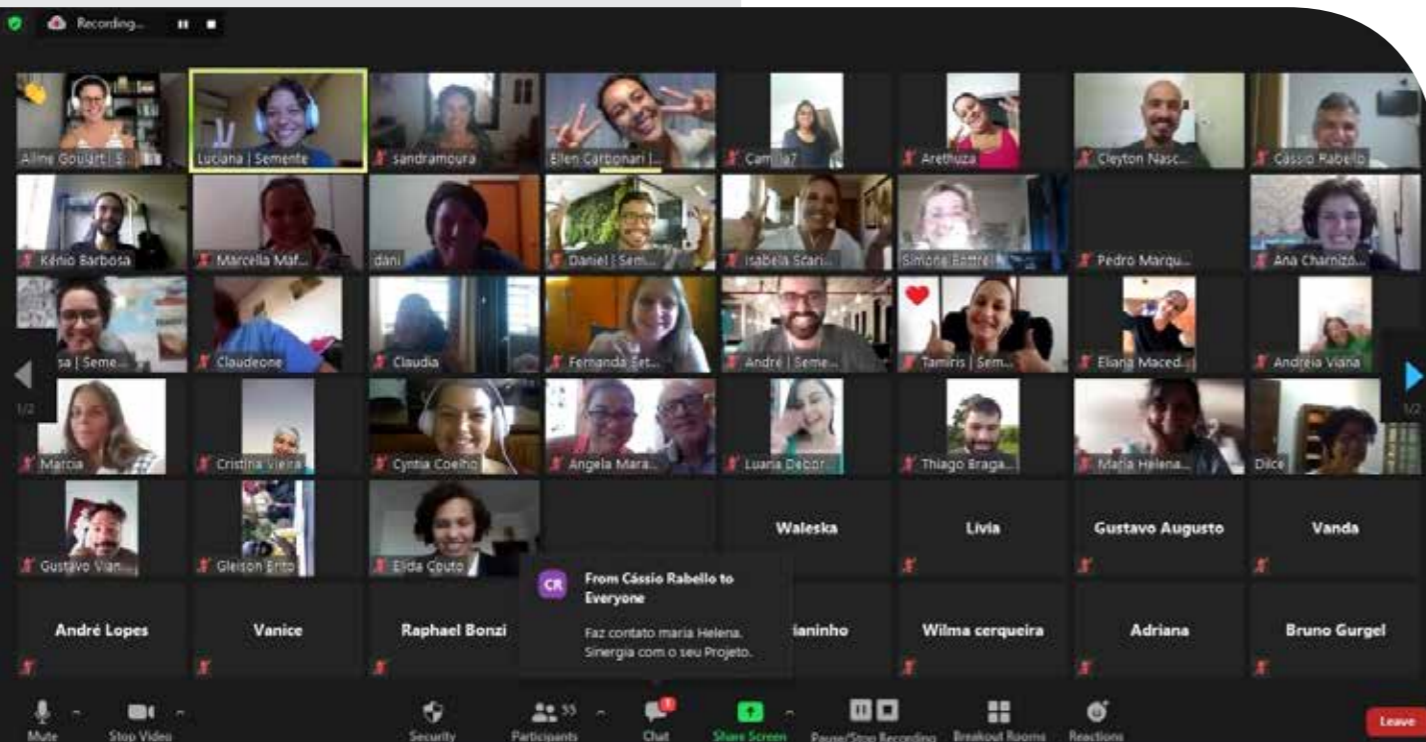
By means of projects and programs in different areas, Vale keeps working towards the recovery and resignification of Córrego do Feijão. The works of the Project Território-Parque are in progress for the implementation of the structures of the central area.



The activities related to the Community Equipment, started in Córrego do Feijão, have the objective to offer management tools and use of the spaces that will be delivered by Território-Parque. In the next six months, capacitation workshops will be held for the collaborative construction of the business plans and management models of the Community Market and the Center of Culture and Craftsmanship, structures that, shortly, will be part of the life of the community.

In these spaces will work the local social businesses that are being developed by the Project of Social Community Entrepreneurship performed in partnership with the Institute Kairos. Since August 2020, residents of Córrego do Feijão have participated of the activities of the project, that includes workshops and capacitation courses, among other activities that aim at supporting the community's organization.

Capacitation, innovation and income generation in the evacuated territories



Project Horizon On-line meeting

Since the launching of the Project Horizon, in March, 2021, 141 entrepreneurs of Itabirito, Barão de Cocais, Nova Lima, Ouro Preto and Santa Bárbara have been qualified and 78 projects were selected to participate of a technical advisory, workshops and mentoring cycle that is already in progress.

The Project Horizon is held in partnership with Semente Negócios, and it seeks to contribute to the economic diversity and jobs generation, supporting and capacitating the residents in the creation of innovative businesses and with positive socio-environmental impact.

Next Steps



In October 2021, it will start the acceleration phase of the social businesses that stand out the most during the advisory, mentoring and workshops cycle. The acceleration will occur for 12 months, where the projects selected will continue being capacitated and will receive a seed-capital of up to R\$50 thousand to be invested in the business.

Impulse to the Entrepreneurship

About 35 individual entrepreneurs and 14 associations of Itabirito have participated, since January, of the cycles of formation and inspiration of the Program of Territorial Development and Social Transformation of Itabirito. The initiative is a partnership with Raizes Turismo, Empreendedorismo e Desenvolvimento Sustentável and was designed to enhance the view of independence from mining, boosting the prominence and local entrepreneur culture of the city. The project works directly in the qualification of potential local entrepreneurs, by means of three work fronts: Creative Economics, Agroecology and Institutional Strengthening.

Embroidering Stories



It is not only a random embroidery, but another opportunity that we have to return to the past, at the time of our childhood, and be able to share.”

This is how the teacher Andrea Campos, resident of Brumadinho, talks about her participation in the project Semeando Esperança. She learnt about the opportunity through her mother, Isabel Souto, who has already participated of the virtual workshops of free embroidering and joined the first class of 2021, in March, together with another 19 people.



It has been very good. I am learning something that I like and did not know much about, and dedicating part of my time to weaving our life story, designing in the mandala a little of our report and learning how to embroider with each situation.”

In July, new students started to integrate the project, that already counts on 47 participants, divided into groups, in accordance with the level of learning, with weekly on-line classes.

Indemnifications

Up to the moment, Vale has already executed more than 5.1 thousand indemnification agreements, between civil and labor, involving 10.5 thousand people. The company continues with its commitment to indemnify the affected people in a fair and fast way.

Emergency Payment

According to the agreement executed on 02/04/2021 with the Justice Institutions and the Government of Minas Gerais, Vale will keep the emergency payment to the affected people – people resident in Brumadinho, or that live one kilometer way from the channel of Paraopeba River, until Pompéu, in the same current models, until August 2021, non-renewable.

Under the terms of this agreement, since February of this year, it is in progress the transition period for structuring, implementation and management of the Program of Income Transfer by the Justice Institutions, that will replace the emergency payment.

Once the transition period is completed, Vale will deposit, in court, the amounts due.

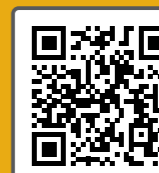
Memorial

It is in progress the works of the project Memorial, that will honor the 270 victims of the rupture of the Dam in Brumadinho. The project, forecasted to be completed in the second semester of 2022, is the result of the dialogue and the expectations of the family members, represented by the Avabrum (Association of Family Members of the Victims and People Affected by the Rupture of the Dam Mina Córrego do Feijão Brumadinho).

Located in the community of Córrego do Feijão, the Memorial will occupy an area of 5.5 hectares and will have three theme spaces (Pavilion, Memory Space and Testimony Space) connected by a crack. At the end of the crack, there will be an observatory with view to the area of rupture.

The conclusion of the works is forecasted to the second semester of 2022.

Coexistence Center

In February, the company delivered to the Association of the Family Members of Victims and People Affected by the Rupture of the Dam of Córrego do Feijão – Avabrum, a Coexistence Center located in Brumadinho’s central area. A house, chosen by the association, was totally renovated and transformed with rooms of individual and collective assistance, play space with monitors for children, leisure area, community vegetable garden and academy. The space was thought by Avabrum so that the family members of the victims can get together to make exchange movements, mutual help, establish connections and attend courses and workshops devoted to resignification of pain, like art-therapy, other Supplementary Integrating Practices (PICs), like yoga, message therapy and acupuncture.

Develop to Strengthen

“I want to learn about public policies, social construction, how to look for improvements for the community as a whole. If it improves to me, it improves to everyone.”

tells us Roziane Duarte, vice-president of the Community Association of the Residents and Friends of Angueretá, district of Curvelo.

Roziane and other 173 community leaders from ten municipalities have enrolled to attend the Program of Strengthening of Social Participation. The initiative, launched in May by the company, has the objective to contribute for the strengthening of the local dialogue forums and boost the social responsibility and transparency in the communities affected by the rupture of the dam and evacuated territories.

The program is 12-month long and counts on a cycle of capacitation, conducted by experts in planning and public management, with focus on the citizen participation, social control, participative monitoring, transparency and rendering of accounts.

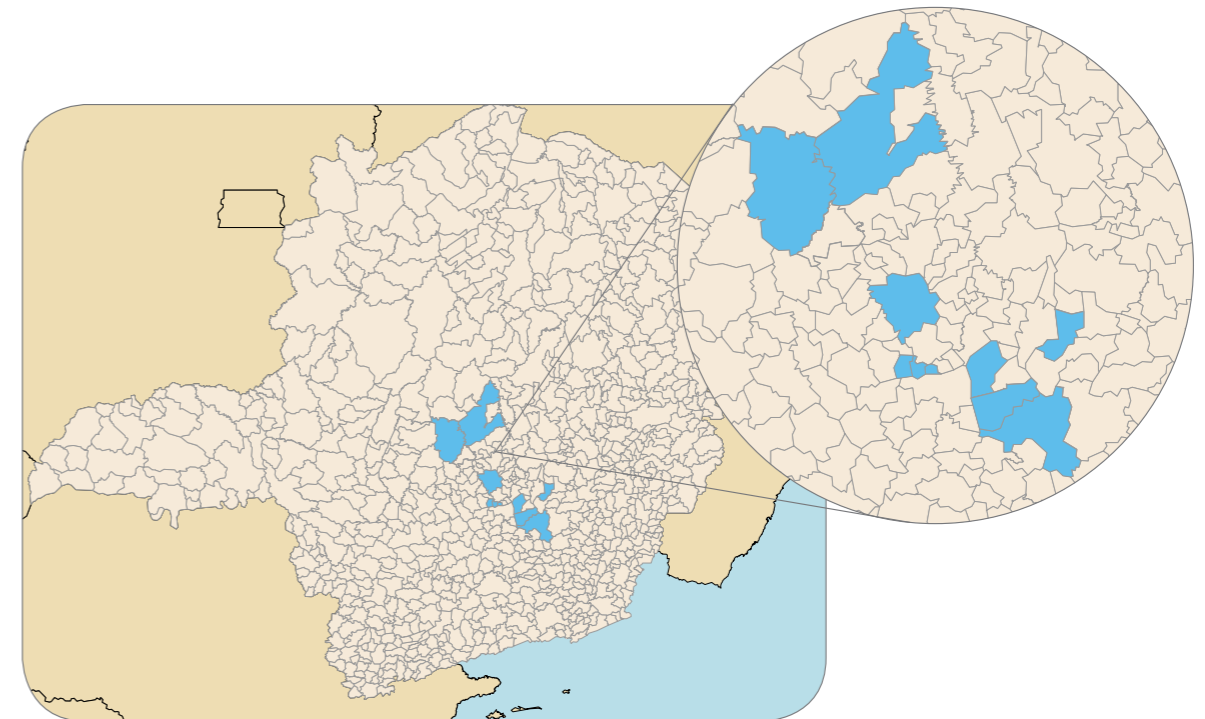

Full Assistance

In order to be able to plan the future facing the new economic and socio-environmental conditions, the people indemnified have access to the psycho-social, financial education, directions for purchase of properties and support for the productive resumption by means of the Program of Full Assistance to the Affected People (PAIA). More than 3.3 thousand people have already been assisted by the program, which is voluntary and free.



Support to basic health



This is a program that has really brought effectiveness in what was proposed to us. In addition to equipment and capacitation actions, it supports the management by means of geo-referencing, with which we can easily identify the epidemiologic profile of the city, and from there, trace goals and actions that will better assist our municipalities.”

affirms the Municipal Health Secretary of Paraopeba, Márcia dos Anjos Ferreira Lopes.

The Healthcare Cycle has arrived to 15 municipalities impacted by the rupture of the Dam I and evacuated territories. Since 2019, when it was started in Brumadinho, Mário Campos and Sarzedo, the program has contributed to the strengthening of the Basic Attention Network where it operates. There are already 1,255 healthcare professionals trained, more than 4.6 thousand equipment donated and 143 Basic Healthcare Units (UBS's) assisted.

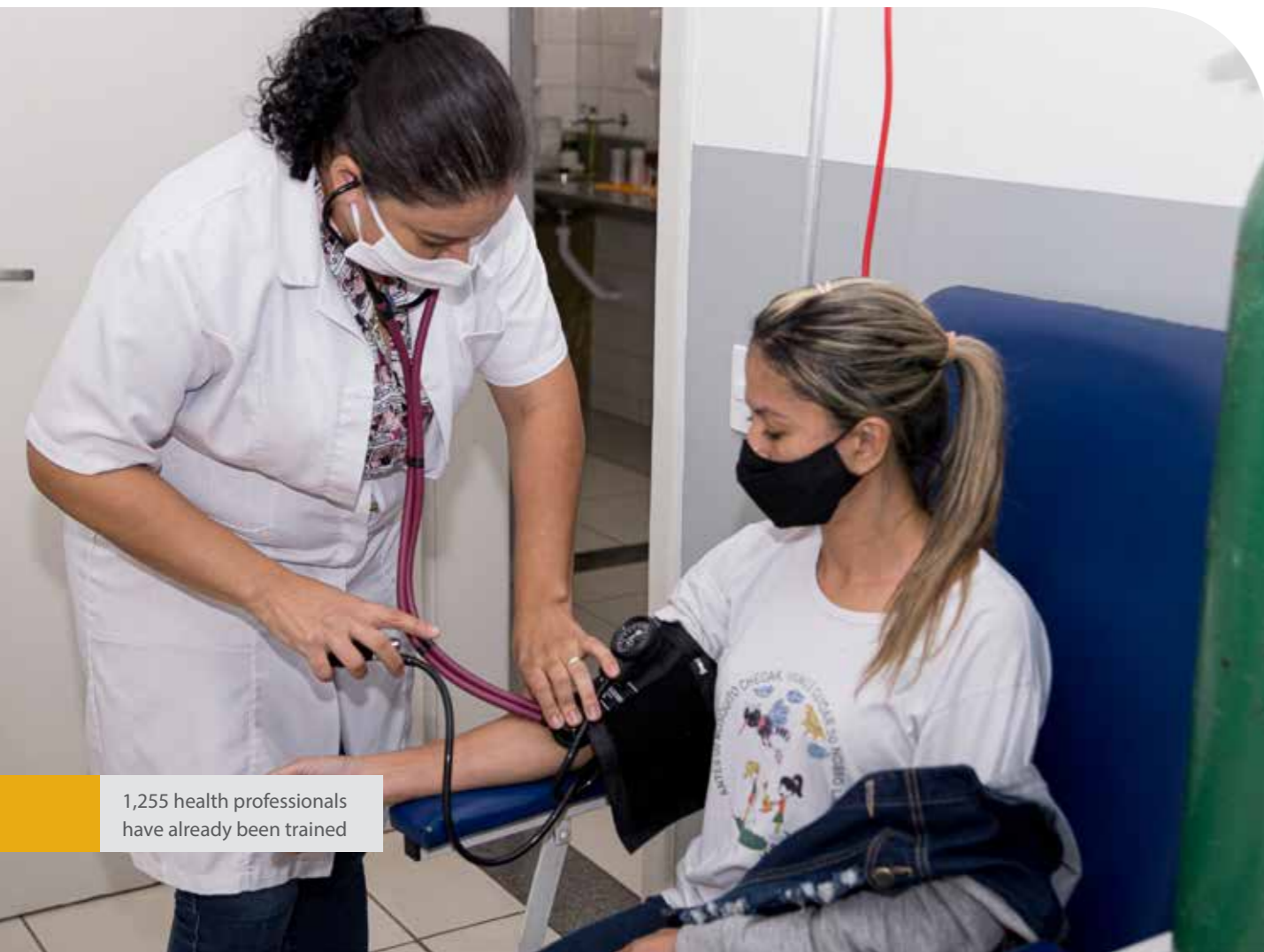

Specialized Assistance

Through the program, Vale is supporting in Pará de Minas the Project Transformation, coordinated by the Municipal Secretary of Health, that has a Healthcare Attention Center LGBTQIA+. The center assists around 140 patients per month, like Gabriela Dias, who tells us that her relationship with the Basic Health Attention has changed a lot. “It is a privilege to count on professionals who assist us and welcome us like this”, she affirms.

Gabriela attends the space weekly for the realization of hormone treatment, psychological follow-up and assistance for the change of her name or record. The Healthcare Cycle will support the creation of a portfolio that will be used in the process of articulation with local companies and institutions, aiming at improving the employability of the LGBTQIA+ public. Those who adhere to the proposal will be offered formations on the theme and granted the “LGBTQIA+ Friendly” company seal.

Environmentally repair the affected territories

The recovery of the degraded areas in the basin of Paraopeba River, in function of the rupture of the dam B1 is one of our commitments. In this chapter, you will see a little of the advances in the last semester.

Project DNA Rescue

Four pilot areas in the region of Brumadinho have received, in the first semester, the seeds developed by researchers of the Federal University of Viçosa (UFV). These plants were created from the rescue of the DNA of the native forest species, an unprecedented technique in Brazil, that helps to accelerate the process of rehabilitation of the vegetation affected.

During last year, it was rescued the DNAs of important species for the structure of the forests of the region, like Jacarandá Caviúna, Ipé Amarelo, Braúna and Jequitibá. The seeds, that would normally take up to eight years to flourish, go through this process in a period from 6 to 12 months only.

explains Vale’s Environmental Analyst, Raul Firmino dos Reis.

The work was performed with the genetic material of 10 plants of five different species, prioritizing those endangered species and protected by law. The process takes place as of the collection of branches from the parent trees that have gone through a process of grafts. From now on, these seedlings will be periodically monitored.

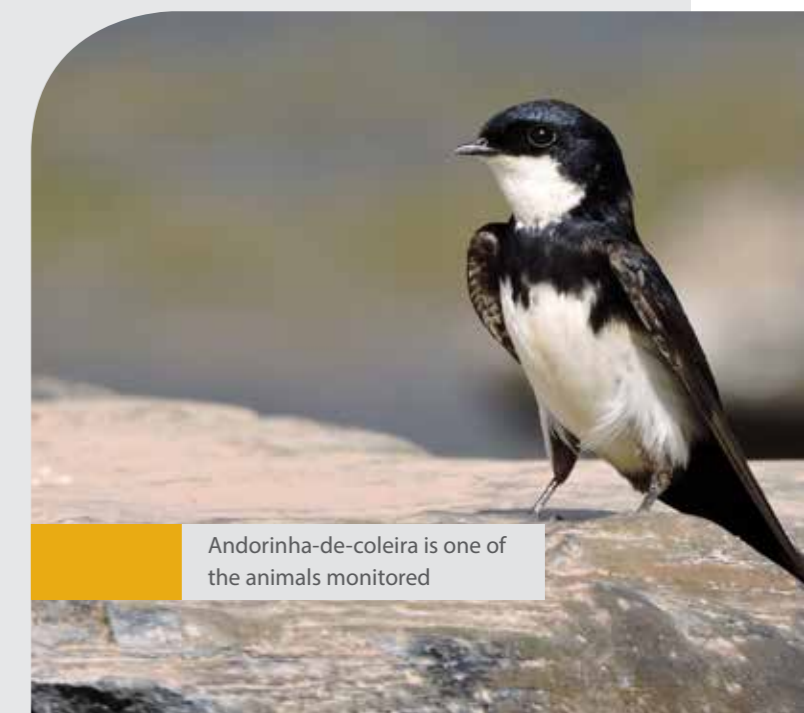

Water Distribution

The supply of potable water by Vale to the people that was dependent on water collection of Paraopeba River in the section between Brumadinho and the Hydroelectric Power Plant of Retiro Baixo, in Pompéu, is ongoing.

Geotechnical security at Córrego do Feijão mine

The dams Capim Branco, at Jangada Mine and Menezes II, at the Córrego do Feijão Mine, located in Brumadinho have achieved the positive Statements of Stability Condition (DCE) and were removed from level 1 of the Action Emergency Plan of Mining Dams (PAEBM). These structures have gone through works in the last two years for the elevation of security factor and keep being monitored by Vale and inspected by independent auditors.

With these two statements, in addition of the positive DCE of dam B6, achieved in September 2020, there is currently no geotechnical structure in alert level in the mines of Córrego do Feijão and Jangada.

Waste Removal

Waste removal is fundamental to support the searches of the firemen and for the environmental recovery of the impacted areas. After the inspection and clearance of the Fire Department, the waste is disposed in areas within the unit of Córrego do Feijão for later definitive disposal in the pit. Before the final destination, it also goes through the screening process to separate waste like metals, rubber and wood.

Animals will be treated and reintegrated to nature or donated to new owners

Vale keeps eight farms for identification, care and shelter of approximately 2,500 domestic, production or wild animals. The structures are in Brumadinho, that also counts on a veterinarian hospital, in addition to Macacos, Itabirito, Itabira and Barão de Cocais. The treatment and care of the animals is done following sanitary and management protocols recommended by the Regional Board of Veterinarian Medicine, by the Federal Board of Biology, by the Federal University of Minas Gerais and relevant environmental entities (IMA, IEF, IBAMA, among others) and audited by independent company designated by the Public Prosecutor's Office of Minas Gerais. In 2021, 40 dogs and cats were adopted.

With the presential events for adoption suspended, on account of covid-19, the site "Take me Home" received around 20 thousand visits, demonstrating to be an important channel for the success of the adoptions.

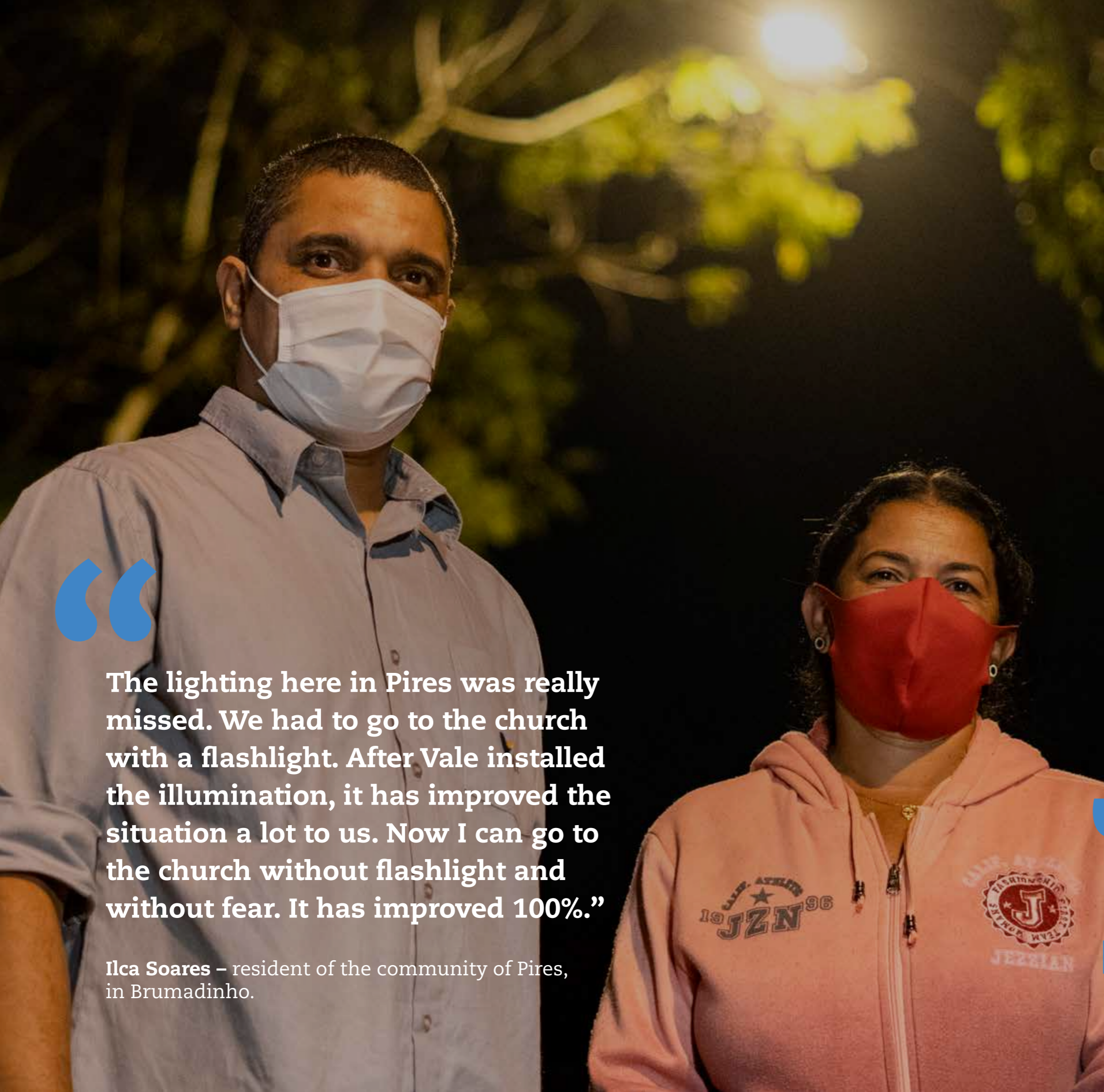
Around 400 animals are still waiting for a new home, and it is possible to see them by the website: www.vale.com/melevapracasa.

Other 48 wild animals impacted by the rupture found in of work areas or in situation of risk in the communities were reintegrated to nature during the last two years. They were clinically treated, welcomed and rehabilitated before returning to their natural habitat. The action is part of the Plan of Fauna Protection presented by Vale and approved by the competent public entities.

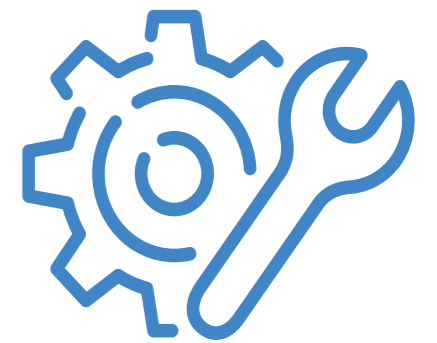

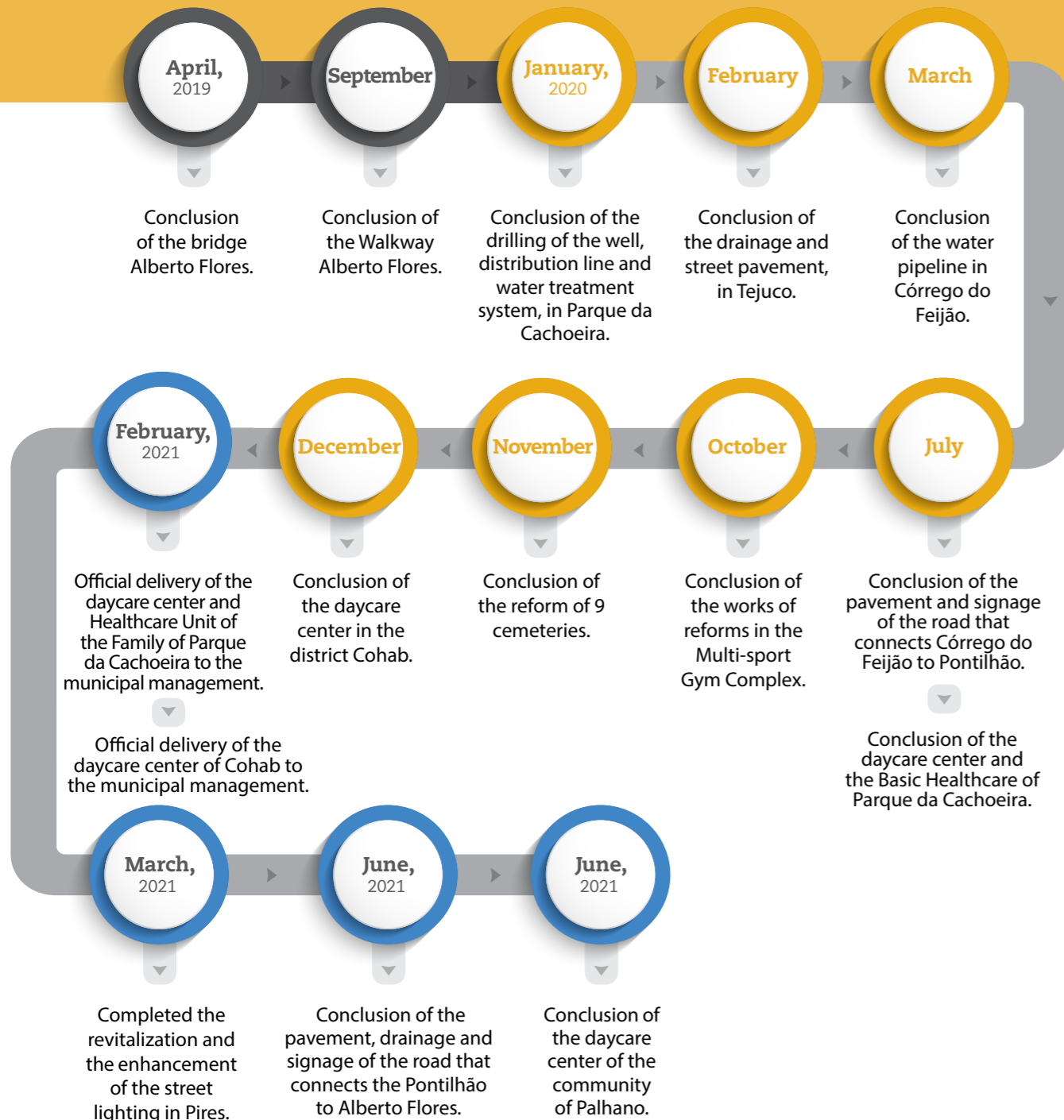

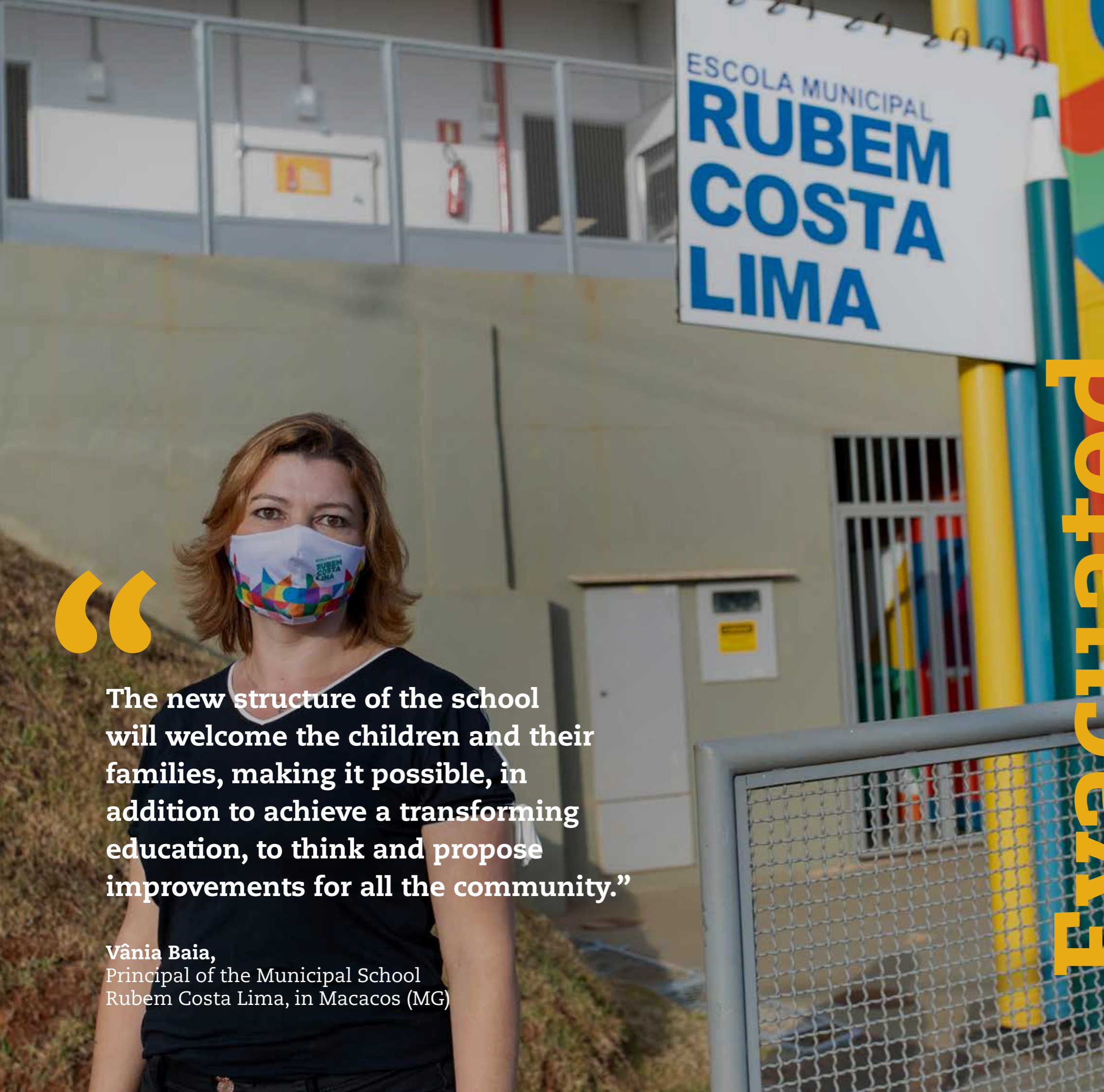

Renovation of Praça da Lagoa

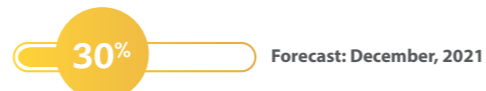

In October 2020, we launched an electronic template so that the residents could choose courses and workshops they had interest to be performed in partnership with local social institutions. We have welcomed the suggestions and started the activities in December.

Social Activities

We completed, in June, the project of social activities offered in the Plan of Repair and Compensation of the Self-Saving Zone (ZAS) to the residents of Socorro, Piteira, Tabuleiro e Vila do Gongo. More than 350 qualifications have been completed with Casa do Artesão, Project Sementes and the NGO Juventude Viração, with on-line and presential classes in the Coexistence Space. Young people, adults, children and seniors could learn singing, guitar playing, keyboard playing, theater, contemporary dance and Zumba, in addition to participating of workshops of school reinforcement and handicrafts.

Water security

Following the commitment to adjust the capacity of the local network to ensure the water supply in extreme case of rupture of the dam Sul Superior, we started, in May, the work that will connect by pipeline, the wells Estrada e Castro and the Water Treatment Station (ETA) of Copasa. Therefore, in case of a temporary interruption of water collection of São João River, the system will be prepared to supply this volume of water preventively. The project has started with the precautionary visits of the residences of the surroundings and shall last nine months, in total.

Reform of the soccer field

The community of district Capela Velha will receive, by the end of the year, the soccer field totally renovated, ready to assist children, young people and adults of the region. Renovation of the Healthcare Center

The Healthcare Center Dona Manoca, in Engenheiro Corrêa, district of Ouro Preto, has received investments to go through a complete renovation, that has the objective to improve the quality of the assistance to the local communities. There shall be change of floor, enhancement of the toilet, internal and external painting, revitalization of the fence and creation of vaccine room and pantry, in addition to the construction of a roof.

Other investments in health

Itabirito received an important reinforcement in the public health network. More than half of the fleet of ambulances of the municipality has been renovated – six out of the total eleven – and the Basic Healthcare Units (UBS) received donations of equipment for health assistance, technological and furniture. More than 400 items, among stretchers, thermometers, oximeters, chairs for blood collection, computers, tablets and routers, chairs and tables were donated by means of the program Healthcare Cycle.



Six out of the eleven ambulances of the municipality have been renovated.

Public consultation for asphaltting

Around 300 people of the community of São Gonçalo do Baçõ participated of the public consultation for asphaltting the remaining 5.2 Km of the access section of MG-030 to the district, made in February. And more than 90% voted in favor. The work will start after the completion of the retaining wall of the dams Forquilha and Grupo. The forecast is August, 2021.

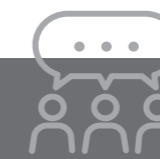
Understand the formation of the committee:

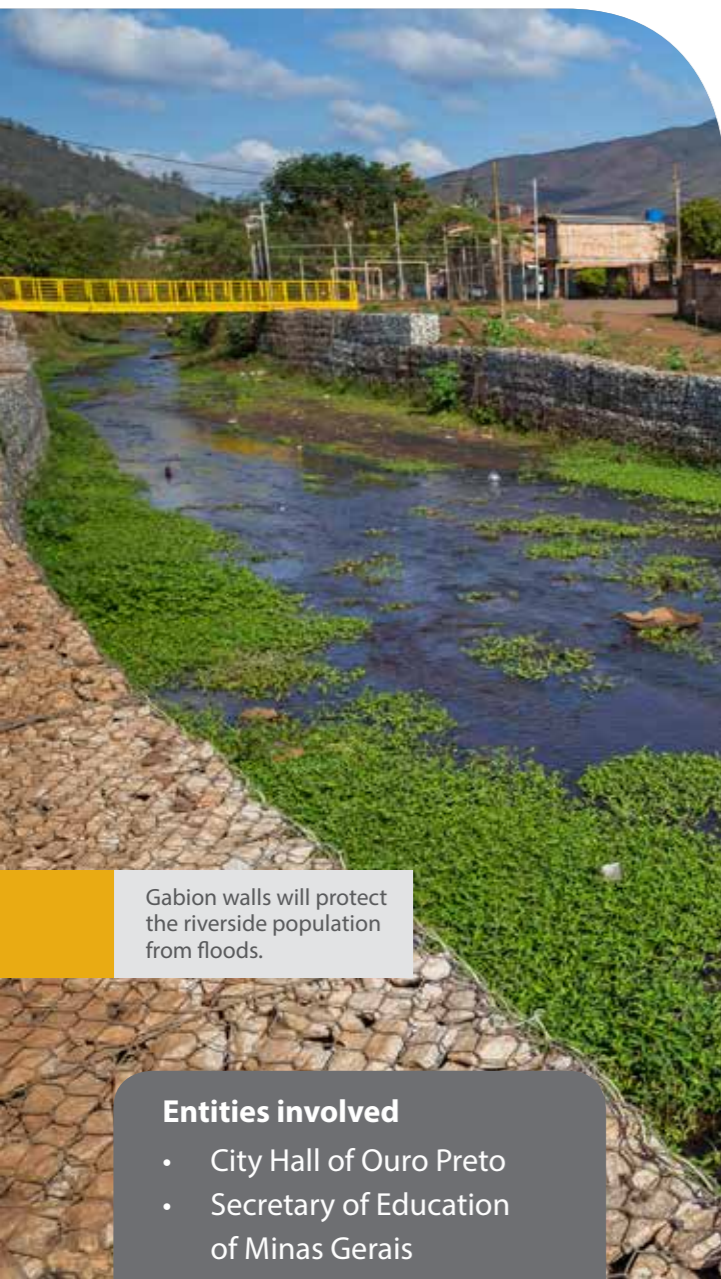

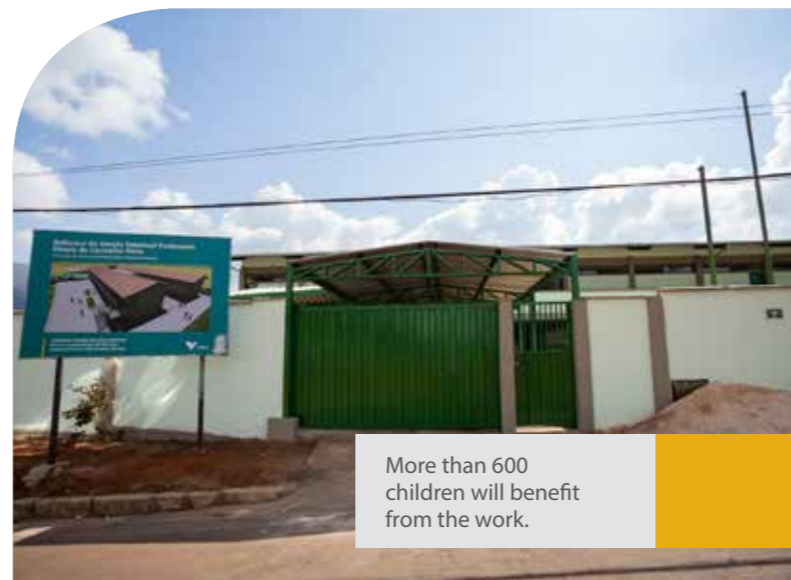

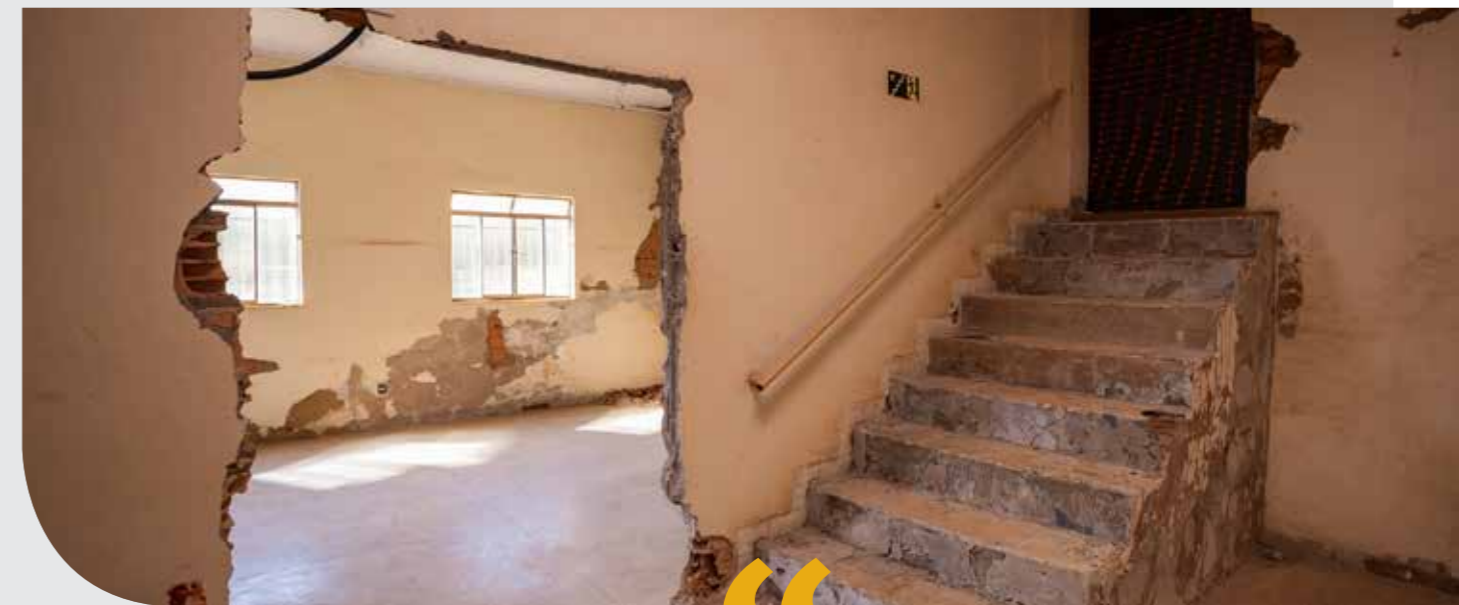

Replacement of the Bus Stops

Reduction of the Emergency Level

The Dam Doutor had its emergency level reduced from 2 to 1, in accordance with the guidelines established in the Plan of Emergency of the Mining Dam. The change has occurred in function of the evidence of the improvement of the structure security factor, after the implementation of a series of actions that have been performed since last year, including the pumping to reduce the level of water in the reservoir and works of improvement in one of the sides of the dam.

Conclusion of new relocations

With support of Vale, Civil Defense completed, in May, the preventive relocation of 34 families residing in the so-called polygonal area, that was incorporated into the Self-Saving Zone (ZAS) of dam Doutor, of Timbopeba mine, after recommendation of the auditing company of the Public Prosecutor's Office of Minas Gerais (MPMG), in February of this year. The families had active participation in the selection of their houses, that were delivered after renovation, cleaning and disinfection. They remained receiving full assistance from Vale.

Vale Responds

With the reduction of the emergency level, will the families preventively relocated return to their houses?

In function of the prevention measures of risks of the works of mischaracterization of the dam Doutor, the people that used to live in ZAS and that were relocated preventively from their homes will continue in provisional houses until the works are completed.
