

Guidelines for filming in the V&A

- Filming must take place within the time limit specified by the V&A prior to the shoot.
- All members of the crew must be supervised by a member of V&A staff at all times and must act as advised by the V&A staff member.
- Only trained technical service managers can touch or move objects in the Museum. Anything that needs to be moved must be arranged at least two weeks in advance.
- Tripod legs must be folded up when moving around the Museum to avoid damaging objects.
- Additional cabling, lighting, tracks or other large equipment will not be allowed in the Museum during opening hours and must be agreed in advance with the V&A
- All equipment brought into the Museum is the responsibility of the crew and must not be left unattended.
- No food or drink is allowed in the Galleries. If you need to stop for refreshments you must make alternative arrangements.
- No chemical products are allowed in the Galleries (including but not limited to make-up, body sprays, hair sprays etc)
