3. Ongoing: Emoji Proposal Intake 🗨️✍️👁️

Reviewing emoji proposals continues to move forward. The majority of submissions were for more specific objects (21% of all submissions).

The category of “object emoji” makes up 14% of all emoji (the second-largest category after Flags) but it ranks 6 of 9 for actual usage based on [Unicode frequency data](#).

However, three smaller but more popular categories (Animals & Nature, Smiles & Emotions,

Food & Beverage) made up 45% of proposals, giving the ESR ample opportunity to approve emoji that are likely to be widely used.
